NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 ENTRY

- 1.1. The End of Summer Hummer Regatta is open to all keelboats.
- 1.2. Entry is by contacting Regatta Committee members Doug Stuart/Bill Young

2.0 FEES

- 2.1. The regatta fee is \$150 per boat and includes one Saturday Dinner ticket. Buffet-style meals (Friday & Sunday) & coffee/snacks (Saturday & Sunday) will also be provided.
- 2.2. To CONFIRM REGISTRATION contact (commodore@sylvansailing.ca). Any additional dinner tickets requirements must be confirmed PRIOR TO 06 September through (social@sylvansailing.ca). Options for the meal are pulled pork or shaved beef. There is also a vegetarian choice of lasagna available on pre-order. (The dinner will be held at the Sylvan Lake Legion, 4916-50 Ave.
- 2.3. Buffet-style meals will be provided for both Friday (during registration process) and Sunday (post racing). Coffee & snacks will be provided on both Saturday & Sunday mornings. Meal tickets are available for \$35 each & payable during registration on Friday & Saturday morning.

3.1 **For both Saturday 16th & Sunday September 17th no races will begin after 15:00 hrs.**

4.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. SLSC Wednesday night racing sailing instructions will be followed using the current RRS 2021-24.
- 4.2. The intention is to run as many races as possible (weather permitting) within the stated times. Races will hopefully be close to 45 - 60 minutes duration.



- 4.3. No Protests will be heard (this changes RRS #60).
- 4.4. All visiting boats are reminded to clean their hulls prior to launching at Sylvan Lake.

5.0 VENUE

- 5.1. Racing will be conducted in the South-East area of the Sylvan Lake.

6.0 THE COURSES

- 6.1. The courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward.

7.0 SCORING

- 7.1. A Low-Point Scoring System will apply.
- 7.2. One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.3. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boats score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.4. When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boats score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

7.5. HANDICAPPING

- 7.6. The corrected time will be calculated using PHRF Time-on-Time Handicapping. The conversion formula is $700/(550 + \text{PHRF})$.

8.0 DIVISIONS

- 8.1. There will be a minimum of two divisions:
- 8.2.

Division 1 – PHRF 174 & less

Division 2 – PHRF 175 & greater. Boats registered in Division 2 without a spinnaker will have a PHRF adjustment of 18 seconds/mile.

9.0 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 9.1. Radio communications on the RC boat will be on Channel 9, all boats are strongly encouraged to monitor the RC boat for start sequences, signal alerts & other potential urgent messages to the fleet.

10.0 PRIZES

- 10.1. Prizes will be awarded in each division on, Sunday, September 17th, as follows:

2-5 yachts 1st

6 or more yachts 1st, 2nd & 3rd places

11.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta and its related events entirely at their own risk.
- 11.2. The Sylvan Lake Sailing Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12.0 INSURANCE

- 12.1. Each participating boat shall provide evidence of valid third-party liability insurance with coverage of not less than \$2,000,000 dollars, not to exclude racing.
