

RC Boat Information

Please ensure your crew is aware of race dates and times. Any changes made to this schedule will be communicated a message to the skippers.

Like jury duty, you may be assigned a date for RC duty. The Fleet Captain requests that you indicate any preferences for assignment dates by email to fleetcaptain@sylvansailing.ca We will consider your scheduling request if possible. It goes without saying that if you would like to preform RC duty on several dates the club would be happy to have you. RC volunteers will be awarded 3 points if their boat has to miss racing because of performing RC duty.

There are some areas where help would be appreciated:

- Coordinating RC duty by providing advance notification of assigned dates to volunteers,
- Ensuring each assigned RC crew is prepared with: signal flags, air horn, score sheet, etc.,
- Assist in setting race courses if/when necessary,
- Provide assistance to the score keeper if necessary,
- Assisting with assessment of any racing protests that are submitted,
- Evaluating handicap ratings when a valid request has been made,

(If you are able to be involved please indicate by a message to the Fleet Captain.)

At the spring meeting there will be a short presentation about the updated Racing Rules of Sailing. Following that there will be a discussion about: techniques, strategies, and tactics to assist decision making on the race course.
